

France in 1713




Terminology

colony- a new land settled and controlled by citizens of a distant country

parent country- the country that controls a colony

triangular trade- an economic system in which a colony could trade <u>only</u> with its parent country or with other colonies of the same country

Triangular Trade



Why would France want colonies?

France thought that having colonies would help make them rich. The colonies would send needed supplies to France and France would sell the colonies manufactured goods. The colonies would only be allowed to purchase goods from France or other French territories.

Goods sent to France

New France sent timber, fur, and fish to France.







Goods sent to France

The Antilles sent sugar, rum, tobacco and molasses to France.







Goods traded among the Colonies

New France sent timber, fur, fish, and peas to The Antilles.









Goods traded among the Colonies

The Antilles sent sugar, rum, tobacco, molasses and coffee to New France.



Goods sent to the Colonies

France sent manufactured goods to New France and the Antilles such as cooking pots, rifles and farm tools.
